BILLING INFORMATION

- Registration/Supply Fee (one time payment)
One child \$50
Multiple Children \$75
- Weekly tuition is drafted every Friday
- Tuition is consistent regardless of how many days a week a child attends
- There is a 20% discount for the 2nd child, 30% for the 3rd child, and 40% for the 4th child.
- Limited in-house financial assistance is available. You can apply at the YMCA. Please allow 2 weeks for processing.
- There may be opportunities for additional financial assistance. We will make an announcement when more information is available.

TUITION OPTIONS

Option A:

Includes but is not limited to;

- Children in any grade doing homeschool/online schooling.
- Children in grades K-3 in District 7 who are attending Hybrid Schooling., will attend after school 2 days a week and full days 3 days a week.
- Children in grades 4th-6th in any district.

Option B:

- Only for Three Rivers Students in grades K-3
- Children will be bused afterschool Monday-Thursday
- Full day care is provided every Friday
- Please note that the week of September 8th and September 14th full day care will be provided everyday. Cost will be \$175 for members/\$215 for non-members per week.

OPTIONS OF CARE

- Full day care is available for children in 4th-6th grade.
- Afterschool and full day care will be provided as needed for children in K-3rd grade.
- Allendale, Highland, Riverside, Parkside, Lincoln, Redwood, Madrona and Fruitdale Elementary Schools will bus children to the designated locations.
- Prices will differ by district for children in grades K-3
